How to download your textbook for Calculus:

You must first create an account on the website, prior to uploading the book on the app.

- 1) Go to bookshelf.vitalsource.com
- 2) If you do not already have an account, click on "Create an Account"
- 3) Enter email
- 4) Fill in necessary information and agree to the "Terms of Use" and "Privacy Policy"
- 5) Click "Create"
- 6) Click on "Redeem Code" and use the individual code I assigned you
- 7) You should see our book "Calculus of a Single Variable, AP Edition, 6e

Once you have created your account you will need to download the bookshelf App.

- 1) Go to App Store and search for Vitalsource Bookshelf
- 2) Download the App
- 3) Use your email and password you just created
- 4) Accept the "Terms of Use" and "Privacy Policy"
- 5) Click the down arrow to download the book to your device
 - a) You will probably want to do this while you are on wifi so it won't use a ton of your data
 - b) It works on our school wifi
 - c) Once you have downloaded the book, it will be on your device and not require internet access
 - d) There are SOME somewhat interactive features on the app, such as note taking/highlighting/sharing your book and/or notes with study mates. If you do anything on your book when you do not have internet access, it will upload to your account once you have internet access (and once again use a fair amount of data so be careful ⁽ⁱ⁾)

You can have the book downloaded on up to FOUR devices/computers, but you can only download it to one Apple device. So, if you have an iPhone and an iPad, you need to pick which one you want your book on and do not download it on the other.

You still have online access to all of the awesome features on the CourseMate such as solution videos, lecture videos, practice quizzes, etc. if you have internet access with Flash.

You now have access to a PDF version of the book that does not require Flash or Internet access. Let's Calculus! (Yes, calculus was used as a verb and no, I am not an English teacher!)
